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### Japan's Basic Policy toward Myanmar


- 1. Retaining Dialogue
- To urge the Government of Myanmar to promote Democratization. (democratization with all the relevant parties inclusive, release of all the political detainees, reconvene dialogue between the Government and the opposition, etc.)
- 2. Providing Limited Economic Assistance
- Limited from 2003 for concerns regarding the situation in Myanmar.
- (1) Highly urgent and humanitarian projects, (2) Human resource development for the democratization and the economic reform, and (3) Projects for CLMV countries or the whole ASEAN are exceptionally implemented.
- 3. Cooperating with UN and international community

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## Japan's Humanitarian Assistance in Myanmar

- Humanitarian Assistance for the Cyclone Nargis Disaster: approx. <u>46 Million Dollars</u>
- Its Focused Areas:
  - Agriculture
  - Construction of School Buildings
  - Disaster Risk Reduction

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# Effective Approach to Myanmar (1)

"Dialogue" + "Conveying concerns"

- Keep conveying concerns and making requests on specific issues for the democratization to Myanmar leaders.
- Encourage the Government of Myanmar to take concrete steps toward the 2010 election so that it would be welcomed by the international community.
- Respond positively to substantive political progress undertaken by the Government of Myanmar as agreed in the Chair's Summary of G8 Hokkaido Toyako Summit 2008.
  - "We are prepared to respond positively to substantive political progress undertaken by Myanmar."

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### **Effective approach to Myanmar (2)**

**Coordination among key stake-holders** 

- 1. Close coordination among relevant members is necessary in UN or other international arena
- 2. Send a single message accorded by international community to Myanmar

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
